

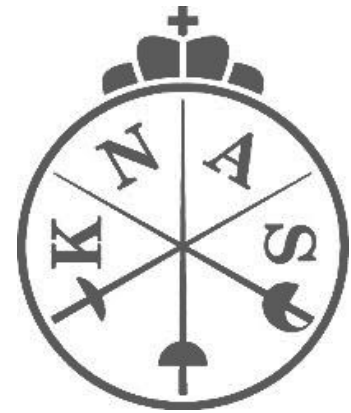
# CONTINUE FENCING

## What's this about?

Safety is of paramount concern while fencing. For this reason fencing is regulated by the 'Fédération Internationale d'Escrime' (FIE). On a national level fencing is overseen by the 'Koninklijke Nederlandse Algemene Schermbond', also known as the KNAS. While fencing is a sport with an extremely low injury rate, the KNAS takes out an insurance policy for all members, covering costs in the rare case of a serious fencing injury. They also perform a myriad of other tasks, from promoting fencing to providing fencing equipment, from organising tournaments to training upcoming talent.



Based on these, and other reasons, A.S.S.V. Esprit requires all members who have been fencing for a period of more than six months to become a member of the KNAS.

## What are the costs?

	<i>Senior</i>	<i>Youth</i>
<i>Full Year</i>	~€50	~€25
<i>Half Year</i>	~€25	~€12

KNAS-membership runs from January to January, however a half-yearly option is possible, running from July to January. Different costs apply for seniors (21 or older) and for youth (20 or younger).

## How do you apply?

Applying for KNAS-membership can be done by filling the details on the bottom of this leaflet, and returning it to a board member of A.S.S.V. Esprit. The application process will be set in motion upon receiving the relevant membership fee, which must be transferred within a period of 14 days to IBAN 'NL15 INGB 0004 5123 84' under the name 'ASSV Esprit'. You will receive notice from the board upon a successful application, containing your personal membership details.
